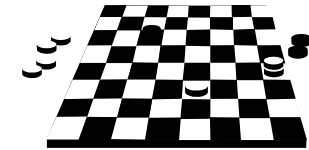
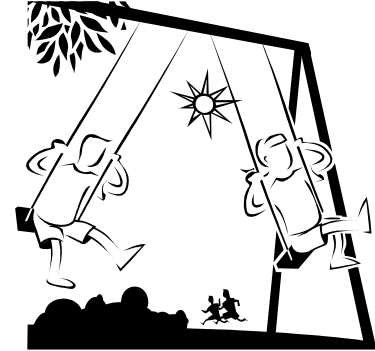

WHAT IS SAC?

SAC is a flexible before and after school childcare program. It provides the students of Anchor Bay schools an opportunity to socialize with friends, learn new skills, test their creativity & imagination, and participate in various games and activities.

For parents, SAC gives you peace of mind. You know your child is being cared for and supervised by trained, caring adults who enjoy being with large groups of school-age children.

For children, SAC provides a fun place to come to before and after school hours to play games, hang out with friends, listen to music, finish your homework, make crafts or play outside.

WHAT DO WE DO AT SAC?

Children choose from a variety of activities throughout each session. These may include:

- Games & sports
- Arts & crafts
- Science experiments

WHAT ARE THE SAC HOURS?

6:30a.m. until the start of school



From dismissal time to 6:00p.m.

HALF - DAYS AT SAC

Afternoon SAC begins from the time school dismisses at lunchtime until 6:00p.m.

HOW ABOUT FOOD?

Included in the tuition price, children will be offered a morning snack and/or an afternoon snack.

Snack: includes a choice of milk or juice and one food item. Children are always welcome to bring in their own snack.



Breakfast: children are welcome to bring their breakfast into the SAC rooms in the morning.

Lunches: On $\frac{1}{2}$ days, all students will need to bring in a cold SACK lunch and beverage.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Registration Fee: \$20.00 per child

Hourly Charge: \$3.50 per hour

Minimum Charge: 1 hour in the morning
1 hour in the afternoon

$\frac{1}{2}$ hour charges:

After the initial 1 hour charge for each session, charges will accrue on the $\frac{1}{2}$ hour of \$1.75.

Charges Begin:

SAC charges accrue from the time child is signed into SAC until the time they are signed out. Failure to sign your child in/out will result in a maximum charge.

When to Pay:

Tuition is always due 2 weeks in advance. Parents need to estimate the number of hours children will be in SAC each week. Money stays in child's account similar to a savings account and debit card system.

Return Check Fee:

\$25 charge for returned checks

Late Fees:

.50 per minute/per child after 6p.m.

See Parent Handbook for excessive late fees.

FIA:

Payments are accepted.

Parents are responsible for any difference in payment not covered by FIA.

FIA does not pay for registration or late fees.
